# Things to Note

### Bargaining Update

On October 12th the District stated that they had no authority to counter our salary proposal and would not have authority until after the November 17th School Board meeting.

The District cancelled our last bargaining date on Wednesday, October 26.

The BTA bargaining team met with the District on Wednesday, November 9. The District provided BTA with counter proposals but stated they could not make a salary proposal. With some encouragement from Salina Serricchio-Joiner (our CTA staff person) the District did make a counter on salary that was not acceptable to BTA. BTA has made another salary counter. The District will take our counter to the School Board on November 17th.

We will meet with the District to bargain again on November 30 and December 14.

BTA appreciated the show of support from members across the District! We saw lots of pictures with members wearing their stickers. Together we are stronger!
